Lomita's Newest Park, Teuchert Park, Dedicated on April 25th

On April 25, the City held a Dedication Ceremony for Teuchert Park, located at 1846 W. 259th Place. The vision for Teuchert Park was initially created by Louis Teuchert in 2012 when he contacted the City with an interest in donating his property to the City as part of his will for a future park or museum site. Born in San Pedro in 1927, Louis Teuchert moved to Lomita in 1936. After graduating from Narbonne High School, he served in the Navy during WWII. The park is also named about Louis's brother, Private First Class William Joseph Teuchert, who lost his life in the Korean War in 1951.

At approximately 20,000 square feet, Teuchert Park has been designed as a passive park space, perfect for an evening stroll or a quick outing with the kids. Mr. Teuchert was a collector of statues, several of which have been incorporated into the park design.

In addition to the Teuchert family, the City of Lomita is grateful to the LA County Board of Supervisors and the LA County Regional Park and Open Space District for providing grant funding to complete the park improvements. It is the City's hope that this space will be utilized and enjoyed by many nearby residents who have not had parkland within walking distance and expect that it will be enjoyed by many generations to come.



LOMITA COMMUNITY Emergency Response Team (CERT) Volunteers Needed!

Lomita CERT is a volunteer program for residents and business people who are trained to assist themselves, their families, their neighbors, and the City in the event of a major emergency or disaster. It is important to know, if a major disaster occurs, police, fire, and medical personnel will be deployed FIRST to major incidents, such as collapsed buildings and structure fires. That is why you MUST be prepared to take care of yourself. Individuals who have taken the CERT course are far more equipped to deal with their circumstances without needing aid from outside sources and may even be able to assist their neighbors and coworkers. The CERT training is a 24 hour course that was developed by FEMA and covers topics such as disaster preparedness, team organization, medical operations, fire suppression, and much more. CERT classes are open to anyone in the community over age 18 and are FREE.



WANT TO GET INVOLVED? Lomita CERT is seeking volunteers to serve as leaders and/or participants in neighborhood CERT teams throughout the City. Participants are required to take the basic CERT training and neighborhood leaders will be given additional training. New Generator Installed at City Hall Will Aid in the City's Emergency Response

As part of the City's emergency operations plan, a 100KW standby generator was recently installed at City Hall. The generator system will fully power the City Hall building during a power outage. In the event of an emergency, the City's Emergency Operations Center (EOC), housed within City Hall, will be the main control headquarters for the City's emergency response. The generator has been sized to support the entire building loads so that the building will be fully operational during a sustained power outage. With the entire building on standby power, the City may run its daily operations without having to shed any loads or essential equipment. The generator has a 400 gallon capacity and can run for 50 continuous hours.




California Division of Drinking Water Finds Lomita Water Provides Wholesome Potable Water, City Plans Continued Improvements

In early 2017, the City of Lomita worked with the California Division of Drinking Water (DDW) to coordinate a regular review of the City's Water System operations and planning. In February, DDW issued a report back to the City noting the City's responsiveness to residents and stating that **"Based on the recent system field inspections, file review, and other related evaluations, DDW finds that the City provides wholesome potable water to its water customers."**

In 2016, in response to residents' concerns regarding the water in their homes, the City established a dedicated website for the City's water system, www.LomitaWater.com, where residents can find up to date water quality reports, sampling results, breaking news items, and most importantly, submit their concerns directly to the City's Water Division. The data received through these reports and our ongoing sampling and testing has been used to track and improve water flow throughout the City, as well as target sampling and flushing where it can have the greatest impact to address those individual concerns. Because of these efforts, the City continues to see increased water quality results in our daily, weekly, monthly, and annual samplings.

In addition to the data driven sampling programs, the City has worked with a targeted group of dedicated residents to investigate ways to even further improve the quality of our drinking water. Through our third party water engineers, the City has reviewed our historic and current water quality data, conducted sampling and testing throughout the system-including inside specific residences, and done bench testing, pilot testing, and computer simulation of various additional treatment options that will not only further protect and improve our water supply, but save money in the process by reducing our dependence on costly imported water.

As part of the 2017 Sanitary Survey of the Lomita Water, DDW noted these ongoing efforts and recognized the City for its dedication to providing clean, safe, and reliable drinking water to our residents. The City will continue to work with DDW and our residents to monitor our water operations and make improvements in the coming years. The 2017 Sanitary Survey, as well as the final report on the City's sampling, testing and pilot programs are available at www.LomitaWater.com. In the coming weeks, the City Council will consider the report and various options for further improvements to our system. Residents can also help maintain excellent water quality by continuing to service their hot water heaters, appliances, and other plumbing fixtures within their homes. Assistance for these types of projects may be available through the City's Residential Rehab Program for qualifying residents. CIF-SS COACH OF YEAR TO HEAD LOMITA PARK BASKETBALL CAMP

Fresh off a California Interscholastic Federation-Southern Section (CIF-SS) Championship and being selected Division 4A Coach of the Year, Camp Director Mike Whiting returns to Lomita Park for a 17th straight summer to oversee the Lomita Park Basketball Camp. Coach Whiting will once again lead the co-ed camp that is open to youth between 5 and 14 years old. Session 1 is June 26-30 and Session 2 is July 24-28. Each participant receives a t-shirt, an individual skills assessment, and is eligible for numerous prizes.

Whiting has deep roots in the City of Lomita. He began his career by working six years as an instructor and coach at St. Margaret Mary School. Currently the Boys Head Basketball Coach at Milken High School in Los Angeles, Whiting has coached at several Los Angeles area high schools. His experience also includes a year as an assistant coach at the University of Tulsa in Oklahoma.

Since its inception in 2001, over 1500 youth have participated in the program. The camp focuses on both individual skills and team concepts. Additionally, the unique concentration drills Whiting employs have proved extremely popular with parents. Registrations are currently being accepted at Lomita Park.
