The City of Lomita encourages you to participate in the upcoming public meetings considering the transition to City Council districts:

- **Tuesday, August 16 at 6:30 PM**
First Public Hearing in the Council Chamber or via Zoom
- **Tuesday, September 6 at 6:30 PM**
Second Public Hearing in the Council Chamber or via Zoom
- **Thursday, September 15 at 7 PM**
Community Workshop via Zoom

The public hearings will be held during the City Council meetings that start at 6 p.m.

**Language interpretation and requests for disability-related modification or accommodation, including auxiliary aids or devices, may be arranged by emailing a request to DrawLomita@LomitaCity.com at least 72 hours prior to the meeting.*

Under a district-based election system, the City would be divided into equally populated districts and voters would vote for one City Council Member who lives in their district. Beginning in 2024, district elections would replace the current at-large election system in which voters can vote for all City Council Members.

The public meetings will provide an overview of districting and the legal requirements. Residents will also have an opportunity to share their input on neighborhoods, communities of interest and preferred district boundaries.
