Recreation Manager Kelley expressed her gratitude for the staff and community during Founder's Day weekend. She mentioned that the fall newsletter was published and delivered to residents. Lastly, she updated on the successful enrollment of summer camps offered at Lomita Park.

Management Analyst Vida spoke on the successful enrollment for both sessions of basketball camp. He also stated that the grant process covering the renovations of the public restrooms at Lomita Park was signed and received. The City is looking to schedule this remodel during the winter season.
