SUBJECT: Discussion and Consideration of the 2022 CIP Master Plan

RECOMMENDATION:

1) Approve the 2022 CIP Master Plan; and 2) Direct staff to incorporate projects in future budget years, as funds are available.

BACKGROUND:

The City's Capital Improvement Program (CIP) Master Plan is a strategic tool for planning purposes. City staff developed the CIP Master Plan by compiling needs from other planning documents such as the Water Master Plan, the ADA transition plan, Bike and Pedestrian Master Plan, the Safety and Housing Elements, and the Pavement Management Plan. In addition, city-wide needs were gathered from City Council, City Commissions, residents, and staff.

To facilitate a thorough process and incorporate community input, the City Council held a Working Session on April 26, 2022, allowing for detailed discussion of priorities in the CIP Master Plan. Following this, the draft CIP Master Plan was presented to the Planning Commission on May 9, 2022, for verification of compliance with the General Plan. Additionally, the Public Safety and Traffic Commission received a presentation on May 18, 2022, on the draft CIP Master Plan. The final CIP Master Plan incorporates minor changes and input by Council and adjustments to fit the FY2022-23 and FY2023-24 budgets. All Commission and Council meetings provided opportunities for community input.

- 2. Provide staff alternative direction

The CIP Master Plan is consistent with the budget.
