



**CITY OF LOMITA
ADOPTED ORDINANCE**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT at its regular meeting held on Tuesday, February 18, 2025, the City Council of the City of Lomita adopted the following ordinance:

Ordinance No. 869, an ordinance of the City Council of the City of Lomita amending Title III (Public Safety), of the Lomita Municipal Code to add Chapter 17, entitled "Unlawful Camping", addressing unlawful camping and storage of personal property on public property, and determining its provisions to be exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act. The ordinance will make it unlawful for any person to camp or maintain camp paraphernalia or an encampment in or upon any public property, including in any street, sidewalk, or park. Violation shall be a misdemeanor, punishable by a fine not to exceed one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00) or by imprisonment not to exceed six (6) months, or both.
