NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

DRAFT 2025 URBAN WATER MANAGEMENT PLAN AND DRAFT WATER SHORTAGE CONTINGENCY PLAN

The City of Lomita will hold a public hearing on Thursday, June 16, 2026, at 6:00 PM, to receive comments on the City's draft 2025 Urban Water Management Plan (UWMP) and draft Water Shortage Contingency Plan (WSCP). It will take place in the Council Chambers located at Lomita City Hall, 24300 Narbonne Avenue, Lomita, California.

The 2025 UWMP assesses the City's water resources portfolio, demands, and planning strategies over the next 25 years as a requirement set forth by the California Department of Water Resources. The draft 2025 UWMP complies with state law requiring urban water suppliers to prepare and update urban water management plans every five years.

The draft WSCP describes how the City is prepared to respond to a variety of water shortage conditions. The City's draft WSCP satisfies the requirements of the California Water Code.

All written comments must be received by email or submitted to City Hall by 5:00 p.m. on June 16, 2026.
