

PROGRAM INFORMATION

Mission: The mission of the Lomita Park Teen Program is to provide the future leaders of our community with an opportunity to learn life long social recreation skills. We strive to accomplish this in a safe and wholesome environment that allows our youth to grow as individuals while interacting as a group. The Teen Program offers a balance of activities, programs, and learning experiences that are designed to enhance each participant's physical, mental, and social well-being.

Fee and Registration: To participate in the Teen Program, one must be at least 11 years old and be no older than 14 years old. Sign-ups are available at the Lomita Park Recreation Office beginning on May 15 at 9:00 am. There will be a fee of \$30 due at the time of registration. Payments may be made via check or card. Checks may be made payable to "The City of Lomita". The attached Registration and Waiver & Release form must be completed by a parent or legal guardian granting permission for your teen's participation in the Lomita Park Teen Program. Signed waivers must be turned in at the Lomita Park Recreation Office at the time of registration.

Field Trips: Teens will meet at Lomita Park for all field trips. Field trips require an additional fee to attend. Field trip sign-ups will begin on the first Teen Night, 7/7. To help us plan and make sure tickets do not go to waste or that teens don't miss out, please check the boxes below for the trips your teen would like to attend. This helps staff estimate how many teens may sign up. Checking a box does not guarantee or require your teen's participation, as we understand schedules and decisions may change. Details about each trip can be found on the inside of this brochure and in weekly parent emails.

FIELD TRIP INFORMATION

Teens will meet at Lomita Park for field trips. Teens may bring extra spending money if they wish to purchase concessions or souvenirs. Weekly emails will be sent to parents with detailed information about activities, field trips, and site policies. Sign-ups are available in person at the Lomita Park Recreation Office and payment must be made by card or check. Checks should be made payable to "The City of Lomita". Only teens enrolled in the Lomita Park Teen Program may attend field trips. Transportation for all trips is generously donated by Supervisor Janice Hahn's Office.

7/16 (\$20): Harry Potter and the Cursed Child at Segerstrom Center for the Arts. Teens are to meet at Lomita Park at 5 pm. The bus will depart at 5:30 pm. The show will start at 7:30 pm and will run for 2 hours and 55 minutes. The bus is expected to return at 11:00 pm.

7/22 (\$20): LA Galaxy vs St Louis City at Dignity Health Sports Park. Teens are to meet at Lomita Park at 5:30 pm. The bus will depart at 6:00 pm. The game will start at 7:30 pm and the bus is expected to return at 10:00 pm.

7/23 (\$40): Fulcrum Adventures Culver City. Teens are to meet at Lomita Park at 11:00 am. The bus will depart at 11:30 am and return at 5 pm. Teens will engage in a series of activities focused on team building and leadership and participate in an outdoor ropes course. A separate signed waiver is required for participation.

7/30 (\$30): LA Dodgers vs Seattle Mariners at Dodger Stadium. Teens are to meet at Lomita Park at 4 pm and the bus will depart at 4:30 pm. The game begins at 7:10 pm and the bus is expected to return at 10:30 pm.

8/6 (\$30): Knott's Soak City. Teens are to meet at Lomita Park at 8:30 am. The bus will depart promptly at 9 am and is expected to return at 5 pm.

WAIVER and RELEASE

I, the undersigned, certify that I am the parent or legal guardian of _____ [teen's name]. I enroll my child in the activity of my own volition and give him/her permission to participate.

Knowing these risks, on behalf of myself and my child, I freely and voluntarily agree to assume all the risks associated with participation in the activity.

In consideration of my child being permitted to enroll and participate in the activity, I agree (on my and my child's behalf, and on behalf of my and my child's successors, representatives, executors, heirs and assigns) to release and discharge the City from any liability, causes of action, claims or damages for personal injury, property damage and wrongful death arising from or attributable to my child's participation in the activity, whether or not such liability arises from the City's negligence in organizing, planning and implementing the activity.

I understand that by signing this release, my child and I (and our legal representatives, heirs, assigns or any other successors in interest) are barred from presenting any claim or instituting any civil action for personal injury, property damage or wrongful death against the City which, through negligence or otherwise, might otherwise be liable to me, my minor child, my minor child's heirs, or other successors in interest for damages.

I HAVE READ THIS RELEASE CAREFULLY AND FULLY UNDERSTAND IT. I UNDERSTAND THE RISKS INVOLVED IN THE ACTIVITY. I UNDERSTAND THAT BY SIGNING THIS RELEASE, I GIVE UP THE RIGHT TO SUE THE CITY. I SIGN THIS RELEASE FREELY AND VOLUNTARILY WITHOUT INDUCEMENT.
