PUBLIC NOTICE SUMMARIES OF PROPOSED ORDINANCES

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Lomita City Council will consider adopting the following ordinances at a regular City Council meeting to be held on Tuesday, September 1, 2026, at 6:00 p.m. at City Hall, 24300 Narbonne Avenue, Lomita, California.

Ordinance No. 898 would add Part 3 to Title XII, Chapter 4 of the Lomita Municipal Code to prohibit the use of potable water for irrigation of nonfunctional turf on certain commercial, industrial, institutional, governmental, and common-interest properties, consistent with state water conservation requirements. It would establish phased compliance dates beginning January 1, 2027, for public agency and public water system properties; January 1, 2028, for other commercial, industrial, and institutional properties; and January 1, 2029, for common areas of homeowners' associations and similar entities. Certain irrigation uses are exempt, including irrigation for trees and perennial landscaping, recreational areas, cemeteries, fire prevention and erosion control purposes, agriculture, and recycled or other non-potable water.

Ordinance No. 899 would amend Sections 2-11.02, 2-11.03 (a), 2-11.04, 2-11.05 (b), 2-11.06, 2-11.07, 2-11.08, 2-11.09, 2-11.10, 2-11.11, 2-11.12, and 2-11.13. of Title II, Chapter II of the Lomita Municipal Code relating to parks and recreation facilities regulations, including the use of City parks and recreation facilities; requiring dogs to remain on leashes no longer than six feet; prohibiting the feeding and intentional attraction of wildlife; and updating the definition of smoking to include electronic smoking devices and cannabis products. It would also establish regulations for electric bicycles and other wheeled devices in the City; prohibit certain golf and hard-projectile activities outside designated areas; regulate barbecues and other open flames; and establish requirements relating to amplified sound and unreasonable noise; and update enforcement provisions and establish penalties for violations.

Ordinance No. 900 would amend Title VIII (Motor Vehicles and Traffic), Chapter 10 (Oversized Vehicle Permits), Section 8-10.04(a) of the Lomita Municipal Code to establish an application fee for oversized vehicle permits. Section 8-10.04(a), which regulates the application process and issuance of oversized vehicle parking permits shall otherwise remain in effect.
