PUBLIC NOTICE Summaries of Adopted Ordinances

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that at its regular meeting held on Tuesday, September 1, 2026, the City Council of the City of Lomita adopted Ordinance No. 898, Ordinance No. 899, and Ordinance No. 900, each by the following vote:

Ordinance No. 898 adds Part 3 to Title XII, Chapter 4 of the Lomita Municipal Code to prohibit the use of potable water for irrigation of nonfunctional turf on certain commercial, industrial, institutional, governmental, and common-interest properties, consistent with state water conservation requirements. It establishes phased compliance dates beginning January 1, 2027, for public agency and public water system properties; January 1, 2028, for other commercial, industrial, and institutional properties; and January 1, 2029, for common areas of homeowners' associations and similar entities. Certain irrigation uses are exempt, including irrigation for trees and perennial landscaping, recreational areas, cemeteries, fire prevention and erosion control purposes, agriculture, and recycled or other non-potable water.

Ordinance No. 899 amends Sections 2-11.02, 2-11.03 (a), 2-11.04, 2-11.05 (b), 2-11.06, 2-11.07, 2-11.08, 2-11.09, 2-11.10, 2-11.11, 2-11.12, and 2-11.13. of Title II, Chapter II of the Lomita Municipal Code relating to parks and recreation facilities regulations, including the use of City parks and recreation facilities; requires dogs to remain on leashes no longer than six feet; prohibits the feeding and intentional attraction of wildlife; and updates the definition of smoking to include electronic smoking devices and cannabis products. It also establishes regulations for electric bicycles and other wheeled devices in the City; prohibits certain golf and hard-projectile activities outside designated areas; regulates barbecues and other open flames; establishes requirements relating to amplified sound and unreasonable noise; and updates enforcement provisions and establish penalties for violations.

Ordinance No. 900 amends Title VIII (Motor Vehicles and Traffic), Chapter 10 (Oversized Vehicle Permits), Section 8-10.04(a) of the Lomita Municipal Code to establish an application fee for oversized vehicle permits. Section 8-10.04(a), which regulates the application process and issuance of oversized vehicle parking permits shall otherwise remain in effect.
